Being the tenth in a series of biennial symposiums, BIHTEL 2014 – X International Symposium on Telecommunications will bring together researchers from academia and practitioners from industry active in the field of Telecommunications to discuss current development and future perspectives in Telecommunications technologies. The explosive growth in telecom sector, coupled with rapid innovations is throwing up not merely technological but a whole lot of management, regulatory and socio economic challenges. ## **Submission & Acceptance of Papers**

The working language of the conference is English. Submit the full paper limited to 6 full pages, including paper title, authors and affiliations, figures and references. Each accepted paper must be presented at the Symposium within 15 minutes period and the manuscript must be accompanied by a paid registration in order to be included in the Proceedings. To be published in the BIHTEL 2014 Conference Proceedings and IEEE Xplore®, an author of an accepted paper is required to register for the conference at the full or limited (member or non-member) rate and the paper must be presented at the conference. For authors with multiple accepted papers, one full or limited registration is valid for up to 3 papers. Accepted and presented papers will be published in the BIHTEL 2014 Conference Proceedings and included in the IEEE Xplore® online digital library.
